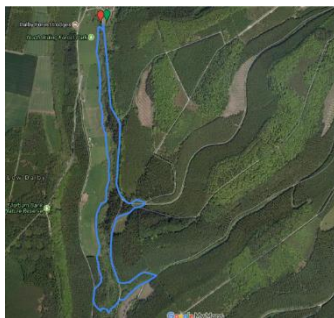




Dalby Forest Santa Fun Run FAQ's

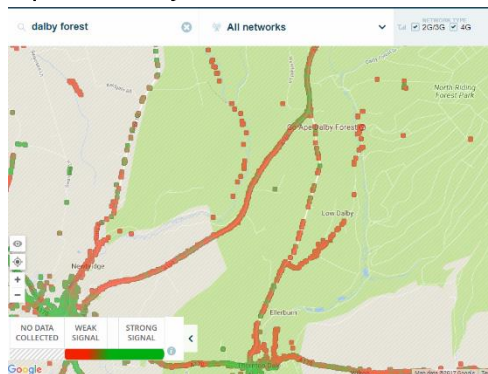
- What is a Santa Fun Run?
A Santa Fun Run is a 2K or 5K run, where all participants usually wear Santa suits.
- How do I register?
You can [register online](#).
- Can I register on the day?
Yes! On the day registrations will be open from 8am outside the Bike Barn at Dalby Forest. First come first serve!
- Do I have to fundraise to take part?
Fundraising for taking part in the event is not mandatory, but if every runner raised £75 in sponsorship an incredible £15,000 could be raised to help more people in Yorkshire avoid, survive and cope with cancer.

You can also raise funds offline, via a sponsorship form, which we can send you upon request.
- Where & when will the Santa Fun Run take part?
The run will take place at Dalby Forest, North Yorkshire, YO18 7LT on Sunday 3rd December 2017, at 9.30am (2K) and 10am (5K). Santa Suit collection is open from 8am.
- What is the route surface like?
Due to the nature of the venue, some of the run will take place on mud tracks. Trail running shoes are advised and we ask all participants to take care when taking part.
- What is the route?



The 5K is the same route as the Dalby Forest parkrun. The 2K is an 'out and back' of the first 1K of the 5K route.



- How do I collect my Santa suit & running number?
Santa Suits and Running Numbers will be available from the Yorkshire Cancer Research Gazebo outside the Bike Barn in Dalby Forest.
- Can I collect someone else's Santa suit & running number?
All participants must collect their own Santa Suit and Running Number.
- Can children take part?
Yes, children can take part as long as they are accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Will there be parking?
Yes, parking will be free for all participants. Please note that vehicles are left at the owner's risk.
- What will I received for taking part?
All participants will receive a Santa Suit to run in, a medal and a mince pie at the finish line. Participants will also receive free parking at the event and a 10% discount on a Christmas tree from Dalby Forest.
- Do I have to run the route?
We advise all participants to only run/jog/walk at a pace they feel comfortable with.
- Can I use headphones?
We would advise runners not to use headphones as this may cause a distraction from the marshals - who may need to give important instructions/information.
- Will there be mobile phone signal?
Due to the location of the run mobile phone signal can be very weak. The picture below shows the strength of mobile phone signals. The route will be supervised by marshals, in case there are any issues.





- Will there be an official photographer?
There will be an official photographer taking photos at the event. If you do not want to be photographed for any reason then please let us know. Keep an eye on our Facebook for photos after the event!
